

# **NOMINATION NOTICE**

## **UTILITY WORKERS UNION OF AMERICA, AFL-CIO LOCAL 369**

Pursuant to a stipulated settlement agreement between Utility Workers Local 369 and the United States Department of Labor filed on September 16, 2019 with the United States District Court for Massachusetts, new nominations, a new election and installation for the office of Trustee-at-Large of Utility Workers Local 369 will be conducted under the supervision of the U.S. Department of Labor.

Nominations for one Trustee position will be accepted from the floor at the November 3, 2019 Regular Membership Meeting, at the date, time and location indicated below. Nominations must be made orally from the floor by members during the nomination meeting. Written and/or self-nominations are not permitted. A member need not be physically present to be nominated for Trustee-at-Large. The term of office will be to complete the 2017-2020 election cycle.

As provided in Local 369 Bylaws, a member, to be eligible for nomination as an Officer, Business Agent, Vice President or Trustee, shall have been a member of this Local in continuous good standing for a period of not less than six (6) months preceding the date of such nomination, and is not barred from holding office in accordance with Section 504 of the Labor Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959.

A Candidates Meeting will be held immediately following the nominations meeting. Copies of the Bylaws and Election Committee rules are available at the Union Office and shall be sent by mail upon request.

A pre-election conference will be held on October 23, 2019 at 5:30 PM at the UWUA Local 369 Hall for all interested parties. The purpose of the conference is to develop rules and procedures and to establish time frames to be used in conducting the supervised election.

Any member in good standing may protest the supervised election for a valid cause; such protest should be made directly to the election Supervisor Janice Melendez in writing (U.S. Department of Labor-OLMS J.F.K Federal Building, Suite E-365 Boston, MA 02203) at any time before, during or within 10 days after the election.
